5. VIETNAM Comprehensive data protection law enters into effect Vietnam's first and much awaited comprehensive data protection law, the Personal Data Protection Decree (PDPD), was issued on April 17, 2023, and came into

effect on July 1, 2023. The PDPD regulates the processing of personal data of Vietnamese nationals, which is notably driven by consent. The PDPD also introduces data processing principles similar to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). 4. INDIA




